

Designated ELD support

Amplify ELD, the companion program to Amplify ELA, provides dedicated ELD instruction following a six-lesson cycle. During each lesson cycle, instruction revolves around text passages pulled from the core ELA text. This approach ensures ELs have ample time to interact with and understand a text, which in turn boosts their proficiency in reading and with the other language domains.

Lesson 1

Conversation & Collaboration lessons focus on oral language development through partner work and small-group activities with the goal of helping students build background knowledge and analyze and produce language.

Lesson 2–5

Students work with two passages from the ELA core text that are integral to understanding the characters, concepts, and overarching message of the whole text. For each passage, students participate in close reading, vocabulary work, and partner and whole-group discussions. In addition, they draft written responses to prompts that are first discussed as a whole class.

Lesson 6

Students work to unpack complex sentences and revise and finalize their written responses to whole-class prompts.
