Galveston Texas June 19th 1863

General Order
No. 3

The people of Texas are informed that in accordance with a provision from the Executive of the United States 'all slaves are free'. This involves an absolute equality of personal rights and rights of property between freed

masters and slaves and the relations heretofore existing between them becomes that between employer and hired labor.

The freedmen are advised to remain quietly at their present homes, and work for wages. They are informed that they will not be allowed to collect at military posts and that they will not be supplied in any other way than through their employers.
