The following assessments have been removed for 2023-2024:

- Renaissance Star Reading
- Renaissance Star Math
- Edulastic Math Common Formative Assessments
- Dynamic Indicators of Basic Literacy Skills (DIBELS): Grades 3-5/6
- Growth Measure (reclassification grades 6-12)

Smarter Balanced Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs) are no longer required assessments. There will also be no additional prescribed assessments at the region level.

The following assessments are included in this policy:

- DIBELS: Grades TK-2
- mClass Lectura: TK-2 Spanish Dual Language
- i-Ready Reading Diagnostic: Grades 3-12



- i-Ready Reading Diagnostic: Grades 3-12 reclassification
- i-Ready Spanish Reading Diagnostic: Grades 3-12 Spanish Dual Language and Spanish speaking International Newcomers
- i-Ready Math Diagnostic: Grades TK-12
- PSAT/SAT
- Advanced Placement Assessments

English Learners (ELs) are now named Emergent Bilinguals (EBs).

Instructions regarding regular communications to families about assessment schedules and results are included in the policy.

- **BACKGROUND**: The Comprehensive Assessment Program (CAP) includes a portfolio of diagnostic assessments to support and inform instruction. For detailed information regarding state and federal mandated testing, please refer to REF-139909.0, *2023-2024 State and National Mandated Testing Calendars*, dated May 22, 2023.
- **GUIDELINES:** Assessment is an integral component of all effective instructional programs. Data analysis and the use of data to plan instruction is a critical part of the continuous cycle of improvement. Thoughtful use of assessment data provides educators and stakeholders with valuable insight about what students know and have learned, any unfinished learning students may have, and where resources need to be focused. The intentional use of assessment data is necessary to provide instructional experiences that accelerate learning outcomes for all students. Regular use of curriculum embedded assessments should also inform instructional planning and personalized support of students.

<u>Best assessment practices</u> should be utilized to create a positive and productive assessment atmosphere for all stakeholders.

NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS Regular communication with families about District and state assessment schedules and results is an integral part of effective home to school collaboration.

Schools are to notify families of scheduled assessment dates and share the results of completed assessments in a timely manner. In addition to sending home a calendar of scheduled assessments, schools are encouraged to use Blackboard Connect messaging, school websites, and school sponsored social media to keep parents



aware of upcoming assessments and when results will be provided. The assessment platforms have approved data reports that can be generated for families and should be provided to families after each test administration.

ASSESSMENT Please see the tables in Attachments A-F for the list of assessments with 2023-2024 administration dates.

- I. Elementary Assessments
 - A. English Language Arts (ELA)

The elementary ELA assessment program provides multiple formative and benchmark assessment opportunities to determine students' foundational reading and comprehensive literacy learning needs.

- B. The required assessments include DIBELS for grades K-2 and the i-Ready Reading Diagnostic for grades 3-5/6:
 - Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS)
 - DIBELS is required for students in grades K-2, including Emergent Bilinguals (formerly known as English Learners), and Students with Disabilities.
 - If an IEP team determines that DIBELS is not appropriate for a student with disabilities, the team must identify an appropriate assessment to use instead.
 - DIBELS is required for students in transitional kindergarten at the end of the year (EOY). At the middle of year (MOY), teachers will administer the Phoneme Segmentation Fluency (PSF) measure to provide baseline data in this skill area.
 - DIBELS is required for all Dual Language Education Program (DLE) students (EB, EO, IFEP/RFEP) in grades K-2, enrolled in Two-Way Immersion (TWI), One-Way Immersion (OWI), and World Language Immersion (WLI) programs <u>except</u>:
 - Kindergarten students in 90/10 TWI, 90/10 WLI and 70/30 OWI Spanish programs.
 - DIBELS 8 is required for International Newcomers.



- i-Ready Reading Diagnostic Assessment
 - i-Ready Reading Diagnostic is required for students in grades 3-5/6, including Emergent Bilinguals (formerly known as English Learners), and Students with Disabilities.
 - If an IEP team determines that i-Ready Reading Diagnostic is not appropriate for a student with disabilities, the team must identify an appropriate assessment to use instead.
 - i-Ready Reading Diagnostic is required for all Dual Language Education Program (DLE) students (EB, EO, IFEP/RFEP) in grades 3-5/6, enrolled in Two-Way Immersion (TWI), One-Way Immersion (OWI), and World Language Immersion (WLI) programs
 - i-Ready Reading Diagnostic is required for International Newcomers.
- C. Spanish Language Assessments Spanish Language assessments measure progress towards mastery of Spanish literacy skills.
 - mClass Lectura Assessment
 - mClass Lectura is required for grades K-2 students (EB, EO, IFEP/RFEP) enrolled in Spanish Two-Way Immersion (TWI), One-Way Immersion (OWI), and World Language Immersion (WLI) programs in all instructional models (50/50, 70/30, and 90/10) of Spanish Dual Language Education Programs.
 - mClass Lectura is required for students in transitional kindergarten at the end of the year (EOY). At the middle of year (MOY), teachers will administer the mClass Fluidez en la Segmentación de Sílabas (FSS) to provide baseline data in this skill area.
 - mClass Lectura is required for Spanish-speaking International Newcomers in grades K-2 who are not in a Spanish DLE Program as a one-time baseline assessment to support instruction.



- i-Ready Reading Spanish Language Assessment
 - i-Ready Spanish is required for grades 3-5/6 students (EB, EO, IFEP/RFEP), enrolled in Spanish Two-Way Immersion (TWI), One-Way Immersion (OWI), and World Language Immersion (WLI) programs in all instructional models (50/50, 70/30, and 90/10) of Spanish Dual Language Education Programs.
 - i-Ready Reading Spanish is required for Spanish-Speaking International Newcomers in grades 3-5/6 who are not in a Spanish DLE Program as a one-time baseline assessment to support instruction.
- D. Mathematics
 - Mathematics assessments measure progress towards mastery of priority math domains and standards at each grade level. The i-Ready Mathematics Diagnostic is the Districtwide assessment to measure students' math skill development in alignment to the California Mathematics Content Standards.
 - Ready Math Diagnostic is required for students in transitional kindergarten at the middle of year (MOY) and end of the year (EOY).
 - i-Ready Math Diagnostic is required for all Students with Disabilities, inclusive of those on the alternate curriculum. If an IEP team determines that the i-Ready Math Diagnostic is not appropriate for a student with disabilities, the team must identify an appropriate assessment for them to use instead.
 - i-Ready Math Diagnostic may be administered in either English or Spanish to students in Spanish Dual Language Education Programs and Spanish-speaking International Newcomers.
 - E. Otis-Lennon School Ability Test, 8th Edition (OLSAT-8)
 - The OLSAT-8 is administered annually to all second grade students as a universal screening assessment for gifted identification in the High Achievement Ability category.
 - The OLSAT-8 addresses disproportionality in referral and identification for underrepresented students, e.g., African American, Latinx, Emergent Bilingual, and students with disabilities.



- F. Assessment Waiver Information
 - There are no assessment waivers available during the 2023-2024 school year.
- II. Secondary Assessments
 - A. English Language Arts (ELA)

The secondary ELA program provides two Districtwide assessments to measure students' literacy skills. They include the following:

- i-Ready Reading Diagnostic (three times per year)
- i-Ready Reading Diagnostic is required for International Newcomers (three times per year).
- The following students are exempt from the i-Ready Reading assessment:
 - If an IEP team determines that i-Ready is not appropriate for a student with disabilities, the team must identify an appropriate assessment to use instead.
 - Grade 12 students EOY administration is optional.
- B. Spanish Language Assessments

The i-Ready Spanish Language assessments measure progress towards mastery of Spanish literacy skills.

- i-Ready Reading Spanish is required for Spanish-speaking International Newcomers new to the U.S. as a one-time baseline assessment to support instruction.
- i-Ready Spanish may be administered to students in Spanish Dual Language Education Programs.
- C. Mathematics

The i-Ready Mathematics Diagnostic is the Districtwide assessment to measure students' math skill development in alignment to the California Mathematics Content Standards.

- All students are required to take the i-Ready assessment except for students enrolled in the following courses:
 - AP Calculus AB
 - AP Calculus BC
 - Discrete Math AB
 - AP Statistics AB



- The i-Ready Math assessment in Spanish may be administered to Spanish-speaking International Newcomers who have been in the United States 12 months or less.
- The i-Ready Math assessment in Spanish may be administered to Spanish DLE students.
- If an IEP team determines that i-Ready is not appropriate for a student with disabilities, the team must identify an appropriate assessment to use instead.
- Grade 12 students EOY administration is optional
- D. Assessment Waiver Information:
 - There are no assessment waivers available during the 2023-2024 school year.
- III. Standard English Learner Assessments

Probable Standard English Learners who receive one or more At Risk Data Warnings (see Chapter 5 EL/SEL Master Plan) will take the LAS Links Assessment (administered twice per year) to receive Academic Language Proficiency Levels and formative data that can be used to provide targeted academic language support for Standard English Learners.

IV. PSAT/NMSQT

The PSAT/NMSQT is a standardized test that provides first hand practice for the SAT and gives students a chance to qualify for scholarships given by National Merit Scholarship Corporation.

V. SAT

The purpose of the SAT is to measure a high school student's readiness for college. The SAT is an exam/assessment used by some colleges and universities to make admissions decisions. The SAT is a multiple-choice test created and administered by the College Board. In 2023-2024, it will be administered digitally.

VI. Advanced Placement

AP Exams are standardized exams designed to measure how students have mastered the content and skills of a specific AP course. Most exams are two-three hours long. The first part of the exam usually consists of multiple-choice questions. The



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second part of the exam usually consists of free-response questions. Depending on the exam, the-free responses could be in the form of an essay, a solution to a problem, or a spoken response.
