BEFORE THE EOY ASSESSMENT:

- Review the amplify.com/alaska website for up-to-date information, resources, and assessment requirements
- Have a student who transferred between districts within Alaska? Fill out [this form](#) (you must be logged in to mCLASS for access) and successfully transfer previous student data

Professional Development

- All staff administering mCLASS DIBELS 8 must complete the Initial Training.

- Review your materials and/or [download testing materials](#), as needed.
- All participating schools should have received one kit per school for every grade K-3. If you are unable to locate a kit, contact your building principal.

Benchmark Windows

- Benchmarks are to be completed within a consecutive two-week window during the State EOY Benchmark window (4/22/24 – 5/17/24). To confirm your window, please contact your building principal.

Device Setup and Login

- Login - learning.amplify.com using the login method of your district's choosing.
 - Trouble logging in? [Clear your cache and cookies](#).
- Navigate to the assessment site and [sync](#) to see the most current class enrollment. If you have missing information, contact your building principal. *Roster changes will take up to 48 hours to reflect in the system.
- Practice administering the EOY assessment with your demo account. Once logged in, visit the [Professional Development website](#) to review scoring rules and practice videos.

Alaska Assessment Administration Reminders

- Develop a schedule to assess all students within the 2-week benchmark window your district has set
- Refresh your understanding of your district's makeup assessment policy

Progress Monitoring Expectations

- Recommendation: students who scored Well Below Benchmark are progress monitored every two weeks and students who scored Below Benchmark are progress monitored every four weeks through the end of the school year.
